



2024 Cochise County Fair Junior Livestock Scholarship Information

*Application packages must be received on or before **May 31, 2024** and will be accepted through the U.S. Postal Service, email or by hand delivering them to the Fair Office. The address for mailing and hand delivering is: Cochise County Fair Association, Attention: Scholarship Committee, 3677 N. Leslie Canyon Road, Douglas, AZ 85607. The email address for submitting electronically is: cochisecountyfair@gmail.com All U.S. Postal Service mailed application packages must be postmarked by May 31, 2024 to be considered. The number of scholarships and amounts awarded annually vary depending on the availability of funding and the number of applicants.*

Eligibility Requirements:

Scholarship applicants must be a High School Senior or attending an accredited community college, college, university, trade, or vocational school as a full-time student (full-time status must be maintained all year and is defined by the specific educational facility's admissions guidelines; failure to maintain full-time status will require scholarship funds to be paid back in full), have a grade point average of 3.0 or greater, are less than 22 years of age, a resident of Cochise County and have exhibited in the Cochise County Fair Junior Livestock Division at least 2 times including their Senior Year of High School. Individuals can apply for the CCFJL Scholarship annually, not to exceed more than 4 consecutive years post high school. Individuals awarded a scholarship are required to complete no less than four hours of volunteer service during the year the scholarship is awarded.

Application Package:

Only **complete** application packages will be considered for scholarships. A complete application package shall consist of: CCFJL Scholarship Application, Essay Question Responses, Current Official Transcripts and a Current Letter of Recommendation from an individual familiar with your achievements (individual cannot be a family member and the letter must be dated after January 1 of the application year).

Successful Recipients:

Scholarship recipients will receive their funds in one installment no later than September 1. Funds will **not** be disbursed until Official Transcripts from the prior semester and Verification of Enrollment with class schedule for current semester is received by the fair manager. If a recipient fails to provide their Official Transcripts and Verification of Enrollment by October 1, they will automatically forfeit their scholarship funds.
